

## Commonly Used Forms and Acronyms for Workers' Compensation

AA	Additional Allowance	Subsequent medical conditions added to a workers' compensation claim
ADM4303	Injury / Illness Report	Form used to report an on the job injury
BWC	Bureau of Workers' Compensation	State agency that administers all workers' compensation claims
CMI	CompManagement	Company that represents DAS as the Third Party Administrator
C-84	Request for Temporary Total Compensation	A BWC form used to apply for TT
C-92	Application for % of PPD	A BWC form used to file for Permanent Partial Disability
C-240	Settlement Agreement	Final settlement of a claim in its entirety
CSS	Claims Service Specialist	BWC employee that processes claims
CW	CareWorks	Managed Care Organization
DISB	Disability Leave	Benefits provided for non-work related injuries or illness
DMC	Disability Management Coordinator	The BWC employee that assists both the injured worker and employee by removing barriers from returning to work
DS/H	BWC Division of Safety & Hygiene	A division of Workers' Compensation
FROI	First Report of Injury	Form used to report an injury
IC	Industrial Commission	The adjudicative branch of the workers' compensation system
ICD9	International Classification of Disease	Diagnosis codes used to identify injuries
IME	Independent Medical Exam	Exam initiated by either BWC or the employer to evaluate injured worker's medical condition
IMR	Independent Medical Review	A review of injured worker's medical records that is conducted by a physician that has never treated the injured worker
LSS	Lump Sum Settlement	A final settlement of a workers' compensation claim in its entirety
LT	Lost Time	A BWC claim filed when an employee misses time from work
MCO	Managed Care Organization	A provider of medical-management services, including the establishment of provider networks to serve the injured worker

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MEDCO 14	Physicians Report of Work Ability	Form used by physician to summarize injured worker's physical capabilities and ability to return to work
MMI	Maximum Medical Improvement	Injured worker has reached a treatment plateau where additional medical treatment would not be beneficial
MO	Medical Only	A BWC claim in which the injured worker misses does not miss time from work
Motion	C86 Form	Form used to request a decision by the BWC or the Industrial Commission on claim
NWWL	Non Working Wage Loss	Compensation received while an injured worker participates in a job search
OIL	Occupation Injury Leave	Benefits to an employee directly injured by a ward of the state. Paid to the lesser of what is medically necessary or 960 hours
POR	Physician of Record	Injured worker's main treating physician
PP	Permanent Partial	An impairment from a work related injury that has become permanent and is partially disabling to the employee
PTD	Permanent Total Disability	An impairment from a work related injury that has become permanent and totally disables the employee
RNCM	Nurse Case Manager	An employee of the MCO that works to ensure an injured worker receives adequate medical treatment
SC	Salary Continuation	Benefits to an employee injured at work but not by a ward. Paid to the lesser of what is medically necessary or 480 hours
TPA	Third Party Administrator	The company that assists agencies in processing Workers' Compensation claims
TTD	Temporary Total Disability	A weekly benefit paid by the BWC to an injured worker suffering from a temporary disability that prevents the employee from returning to work
TWP	Transitional Work Program	A program that provides an injured worker with the ability to RTW while still recovering from their illness/injury
WWL	Working Wage Loss	Compensation awarded to claimants when they suffer a wage loss as a result of a work related injury
