Education conference update at Feb. 26 SEHCB meeting

COLUMBUS – The next meeting of the School Employees Health Care Board and the Public Schools Health Care Advisory Committee will be held from 9 a.m. to 1:45 p.m. Thursday, Feb. 26 at the Ohio School Boards Association, 8050 N. High St., Columbus.

The meeting will include an update about the educational conference that will be held for school district representatives from 9 a.m. to 3 p.m. March 3 in the ballroom of the Hyatt Regency, 350 N. High St., Columbus.

The conference will provide recommendations on how to implement best practices for disease management, wellness programs, access to specialty and transplant networks, and dependent eligibility audits. These best practices recently became part of the Ohio Administrative Code.

The School Employees Health Care Board is studying ways to improve the health care benefits for K-12 public school employees.

The Public Schools Health Care Advisory Committee is a body appointed to advise the board.

The next meeting scheduled after this Feb. 26 meeting will be held March 19.
