

## MBE/EDGE SCORECARD Details

1. Column 1 - State agencies/departments by three categories
  - Cabinet Agencies
  - Colleges and Universities
  - Non-Cabinet Agencies
  
2. Column 2 - Eligible Expenditures
  - this amount includes all goods & services expenditures that can be bid competitively
  - this figure **excludes** expenditures that cannot be competitively bid (i.e. payroll, utilities, interagency, etc.), that are sole source, and/or have been requested by the agency to exclude because the expenditure is exclusive and specific to the particular agency
  - exclusions on the current listing have been designated so with the approval of the State EEO Coordinators
    - they were determined by looking at each accounting code, determining whether it could be competitively bid or not, and determining whether it was sole source exclusive
    - other codes were excluded by having the particular agency make a written request with documentation to support the request for exclusion, and the State EEO Coordinator making a determination of approval (all requests, documentation, and determination are in hardcopy files)
  - "Current OAKS Account Codes Exclude Procurement Codes" listing is provided and divides exclusions by:
    - OAKS Codes
    - CAS Object Codes
    - EDGE excluded or not
    - MBE excluded or not
    - EDGE / MBE category
    - Description of account code
    - list of agencies, 2 year colleges exempt from MBE/EDGE Program requirements (lines 1196 – 1280)
    - list of companies/vendors excluded (lines 1267 – 1280)
    - list of Community Rehabilitation Program, non-profits (lines 1284 – 1385)
  
3. Column 3 - Set Aside Expenditures
  - these are actual good & services expenditures made to certified MBEs, through set-aside bidding, and appropriately flagged on OAKS as a set-aside expenditure
  
4. Column 4 - Set Aside Percentage
  - the percentage calculated based upon actual set aside dollars compared with eligible expenditure dollars
  
5. Column 5 - Participation Expenditure
  - Includes purchases with certified MBEs that were not bid as set aside nor flagged as set aside. (OAKS system alerts user that purchase vendor is a certified MBE, EDGE, or both, and asks was it a set aside purchase, if so flag as such, if not note purchase as MBE or EDGE participation purchase.

6. Column 6 - Participation Expenditures Percentage
  - percentage determined by dividing Participation Expenditure dollars (column 5) by MBE Eligible Expenditure dollars (column 2)
7. Column 7 - MBE Total Expenditures
  - total of Set Aside Expenditures (column 3) and Participation Expenditures (column 5)
8. Column 8 - Total MBE Expenditures Percentage
  - percentage calculated by dividing MBE Total Expenditures (column 7) by MBE Eligible Expenditures (column 2)
9. Column 9 - EDGE Eligible Expenditures
  - this amount includes all expenditures that can be bid competitively (includes goods & services, professional services, information technology services, construction, and architecture & engineering services)
  - this figure **excludes MBE set side expenditures**
  - this figure also **excludes** expenditures for the accounting codes listed on the "Current OAKS Account Codes Exclude Procurement Codes" **exclusions** document lists expenditure areas that can not competitively bid (i.e. payroll, utilities, interagency, etc.), that are sole source, and/or have been requested by the agency to exclude because the expenditure is exclusive and specific to the particular agency (see particulars under MBE Eligible Expenditures - column 2)
10. Column 10 -14 – Expenditures for the Five EDGE Procurement Categories
  - the figures in these expenditure areas are basically by default on the OAKS system,
  - if a purchase made through a company that is on OAKS as a MBE/EDGE or an EDGE and the purchase has not been flagged as a MBE set aside or noted as a MBE participation purchase,
  - it defaults as an EDGE purchase (NOTE: payment card purchases have to be flagged by the agency as an EDGE purchase.)
    - Goods & Services Expenditures
    - Professional Services Expenditures
    - Information Technology Services Expenditures
    - Construction Expenditures (NOTE: this figure also includes EDGE sub-contracting dollars reported by the agency on the construction Contract Tracking System [CTS])
    - Architecture & Engineering Expenditures
15. Column 15- Total EDGE Expenditures
  - includes totals of columns 10, 11, 12, 13, and 14
16. Column 16 - Total EDGE Expenditures Percentage
  - percentage calculated by dividing EDGE Total Expenditures (column 15) by EDGE Eligible Expenditures (column 9)
