

AGENCY AWARD GUIDELINES

All agencies participating in the CCC receive a plaque with spaces for multi-year CCC participation. Each year agencies are given a bar to show their participation in that year's campaign.

- ◆ Agencies reaching their monetary goal receive a **Gold Bar**.
- ◆ Agencies reaching their monetary goal and increasing payroll deductions by 5 percent or increasing their per capita giving over the prior year receive a **Gold Bar and One Star**.
- ◆ Agencies reaching their monetary goal, increasing payroll deductions by 5 percent and increasing their per capita giving over the prior year receive a **Gold Bar and Two Stars**.
- ◆ Agencies who participate in the campaign but are unable to reach their goal receive a **Silver Bar**.

2009 DONOR RECOGNITION ITEMS

All Combined Charitable Campaign contributors of \$130 or more will be given a recognition item for their donation unless they decline the gift on the pledge form. Donors may decline recognition/appreciation items by filling in the bubble under their name that offers the option.

For the first level of \$5 per pay or the one-time gift of \$130, donors may receive a carbiner pen. For \$10 per pay or the one-time gift of \$260, donors may receive a tote bag. For \$20 per pay or the one-time gift of \$520, donors may receive an ink pen. For \$40 per pay and above or the one-time gift of at least \$1,040, donors may receive a ink pen gift set. Interest money earned from the CCC account are used to purchase the recognition items.
